As a mid-scale producer with international market access, the company faced challenges building a supplier list that could live up to its own standards - and those of the globally regulated CBD market.

Going Asset Light: Replacing Your Supply Chain

Our client needed to replace every aspect of its supply chain from genetics and cultivation through CBD extraction and finished goods manufacturing. During its vertically integrated rapid growth phase, investing heavily in best-in-class standards from seed-to-sale allowed the company to build significant brand equity, customer loyalty, and global market access. Replacing each component of this supply chain to a similar standard was a daunting task for the management team.

The company needed to ensure that all biomass was collected to GACP standards by certified hemp farmers.
